

## **One Life Church... “Only God” numbers in year 4**

**572**

This is our weekly Kids Ministry attendance at One Life. The average Elementary School in Indiana has 457 kids

**\$2,138,725**

This is 2014 income at One Life. Particularly significant when you realize our income for 2011-3 years ago was \$1,336,335

**\$182,631**

This is the 2014 income that was given through One Lifer’s phones. That represents a 56% increase over the previous year and is part of total online giving of \$799,265.

**2072**

The weekly average attendance at all One Life Campuses combined. Particularly significant when you realize our attendance for 2011-3 years ago was 1133

**\$33,600**

Our weekly break even number with 3 sites and going into 2015 we are currently running \$34,546 in weekly giving.

**145:1**

This is the staffing ratio of full time staff to attenders. While the national average is much lower, we were recently told that more aggressive churches are able to achieve 100:1. It is a tribute to an exceptional volunteer culture at One Life.

**74,791 @ \$2.26**

With 3 One Life Church sites, we have 74,791 square feet under roof at an average lease rate of @ \$2.26 per square foot. Average commercial lease rates in our area are \$13.65 per square foot. It would cost us another \$17,000 a week at standard rates.

**\$27**

This is the average cost per square foot for construction and remodeling of our first 3 sites. Regional remodel rates are averaged at \$71 per square foot. We spent \$1.5 million on our 3 sites, but at standard rates it would have cost us \$5.3 million.

**1370**

This is our seating capacity for one service at our 3 campuses combined. With three smaller venues it’s notable that this single service capacity is comparable to one of the largest church campuses in our area that seats 1400.

**\$1,030,560**

During our first 4 years while we were launching One Life by building three campuses and stretching to grow a young church, we kept it a priority to invest

outside the walls. Between local, global and church planting relationships in New York, we were able to invest over a million dollars “outside the walls”. And we have a policy that we only give where we go. This million dollar investment is connected to collaborative relationships with over 40 organizations locally and around the world.

### **419**

This is the most significant number of all. In the first 4 years of One Life we have baptized 419 people. Our mission is Helping people far from God experience Jesus. Baptisms are the bulls eye of our work.
